**Correspondence/Request:**

Gretchen read a letter from Piedad Flores requesting money to cover a field trip for the Ballet Folklorico to attend a performance at Wells Fargo Center. \$355.00 is being requested for thirty students. Motion to approve by Charlotte. Seconded by Alina. All approved.

ASFA newsletter sent with ideas for fundraising.

Chamber of Commerce sent a copy of the request letter sent to their members to the Foundation.

Community Foundation has agreed to grant the Foundation \$6,000 for the Arts. Alina was instrumental in securing these funds. The funds will be split evenly among the elementary, middle and high school. Money is to be disbursed throughout the 2013 school year.

Gretchen found a penny jar requesting money to help the Educational Foundation in the back room of her father's store. Not sure how old it is but she thought it would be wonderful to pass it along to Gail Paquette.

A letter received from Jesus Arzarte requesting scholarship funds. He stated that he was unable to enroll for twelve units in the fall semester (10.5 units was all he could get). It was suggested that the Foundation prorate (88%) and disburse \$440, the amount

according to the amount of units he is enrolled in. Motion to approve by Alina. Seconded by Rick. All approved.
