Administrative Regulation

AR 5117.1 - **Students**

Geyserville Unified School District is a "basic aid" district and a district of choice. The enrollment of students who reside in other districts, and are allowed to attend on an interdistrict agreement, brings only a nominal amount into the district's budget, whereas the cost of educating each addition student transferred from another district is the same as if the student lived in the district. It is therefore the district's general policy not to accept interdistrict transfer students who might otherwise be allowed to enroll under Education Code 46600 or 48204(f).

The Superintendent or designee may approve interdistrict attendance agreements for the following reasons:

- 1. Allow children of regular, certificated or classified employees of Geyserville Unified School District, who reside outside of the district, to attend district schools during their employment period
- 2. To allow attendance of a high school senior to attend the same school he/she attended as a junior, even if his/her family moved out of the district during the junior year
- 3. To allow attendance of siblings of students admitted through BP 5117 (District of Choice) already in attendance in the district
- 4. To allow attendance of the children of military personnel
- 5. Other reasons pertaining to unique student or family welfare

An interdistrict attendance agreement shall not be granted and/or shall be revoked if the student is deemed to have discipline or attendance problems or is not making satisfactory academic progress or information stated on the agreement application are false. Additionally, a change in the conditions for granting the interdistrict attendance agreement may cause termination of the agreement.

All interdistrict attendance agreements, with the exception of employee's children, must be renewed annually unless the student is subsequently enrolled under through the district of choice process.

The Board of Education reserves the right of the District Administration to revoke any interdistrict attendance agreement at any time.
