This signature form is to be reviewed and signed by all students and parent/guardians of Geyserville New Tech Academy (GNTA), for students bringing a personal device to school. This is in addition to the Technology Use Agreement that all GUSD students and families sign at the beginning of each school year.

For students bringing personal laptops to school:

I agree to hold the Geyserville New Tech Academy (GNTA) and the Geyserville Unified School District (GUSD) harmless in the event that my student’s personal laptop/device is damaged, lost or stolen while at school. I understand that my student must abide by the school and district’s acceptable use agreement (AUP) in order to continue use of a personal laptop/device on the school network. Geyserville New Tech Academy and the Geyserville Unified School District are not responsible for the maintenance and repair of personal laptop/devices for school use. I understand that I must register my laptop with the GUSD technology department and that I must have an anti-virus software and Malwarebytes (see below) installed prior to bringing the PC (see exceptions below) to the technology support staff. In addition, I understand that I may only use the GUSD wireless service when on campus and that I will not use other commercial Internet services, VPN or any other service/software that bypasses the GUSD/GNTA network and filter.
