<b>Section 6. Face Coverings / Other PPE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● <u>Per CDPH (state)</u>: Students regardless of vaccination status, will no longer be required to wear masks at school starting Monday, March 14, 2022.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Masks are strongly recommended indoors for all.</li><li>○ Masks are strongly recommended on buses.</li><li>○ Masks outdoors are optional for all.</li><li>○ Students are responsible for their individual mask wearing.</li><li>○ Mask wearing will not be monitored by school staff.</li></ul></li><li>● <u>Per Health Order C19-33 (local)</u>: All school staff who are not ‘fully updated’<sup>1</sup> with COVID 19 vaccinations are required to mask indoors.</li><li>● In the event of a confirmed positive classroom case, parents will be notified and highly encouraged to remind their child to wear a mask for at least five days after exposure.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Per CalOSHA requirements, any exposed staff member is required to mask for 10 days after exposure.</li></ul></li><li>● Masks will be provided upon request to all students/staff/volunteers.</li></ul>
