Section 6. Face Coverings / Other PPE

- Per CDPH (state): Students regardless of vaccination status, will no longer be required to wear masks at school starting Monday, March 14, 2022.
 - Masks are strongly recommended indoors for all.
 - Masks are strongly recommended on buses.
 - Masks outdoors are optional for all.
 - Students are responsible for their individual mask wearing.
 - Mask wearing will not be monitored by school staff.
- Per Health Order C19-33 (local): All school staff who are not 'fully updated' with COVID 19 vaccinations are required to mask indoors.
- In the event of a confirmed positive classroom case, parents will be notified and highly encouraged to remind their child to wear a mask for at least five days after exposure.
 - Per CalOSHA requirements, any exposed staff member is required to mask for 10 days after exposure.
- Masks will be provided upon request to all students/staff/volunteers.

¹ Fully Updated" means that an individual is not only "Fully Vaccinated" but has also obtained a booster dose of a COVID-19 vaccination for which they are eligible as authorized by
